

RESOLUTION 05-05

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF
CLAY COUNTY, GEORGIA, DESIGNATING USE OF
INSURANCE PREMIUM TAXES WITHIN THE COUNTY;
AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**


WHEREAS, pursuant to Georgia Code Section 33-8-8.3, the Clay County Board of Commissioners desires to designate the Insurance Premium Tax of Clay County to be used in the unincorporated areas of the County, by the Emergency Medical Services in the amount of \$80,000, and by the Solid Waste Department in the amount of \$5,000 WHEREAS, said Insurance Premium Taxes shall offset the ad valorem tax base within the unincorporated area of Clay County;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commission of Clay County, Georgia, as follows:

1. That the Insurance Premium Tax shall be kept separate from other County funds, and shall be used solely for the operation of the Emergency Medical Services and the Solid Waste Department.
2. That the Clay County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts this resolution for the use of the Insurance Premium Taxes collected within Clay County as herein stipulated.




