

**RESOLUTION 06-002**  
**AMENDING A RESOLUTION IMPOSING A WIRELESS ENHANCED 9-1-1 CHARGE**  
**ON WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS CONNECTIONS WITHIN CLAY COUNTY,**  
**GEORGIA.**

**WHEREAS**, on July 3, 2001 the Commissioners of Clay County, Georgia adopted a resolution imposing a wireless enhanced 9-1-1 charge on wireless telecommunications with billing addresses within Clay County, Georgia; and,

**WHEREAS**, since the adoption of such resolution Clay county has enhanced and improved its 9-1-1 system to that it is now capable of providing and does provide automatic number identification and automatic location identification of a wireless telecommunications connection subscribed to by subscribers whose billing address is within the jurisdiction of the local government; and,

**WHEREAS**, Part 4 of Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 46 of the Official code of Georgia Annotated authorizes local governments to impose a wireless enhanced 9-1-1 charge for Phase II Service upon each wireless telecommunications connection subscribed to by subscribers whose billing address is within the jurisdiction of the local government; and,

**WHEREAS**, under the provision of such law a charge of Phase II Service may be imposed at a rate of up to \$1.50 per month per wireless connection; and,

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held on Tuesday, February 21, 2006 on the question of amending the 2003 Resolution for the purpose of increasing the wireless enhanced 9-1-1 charge to reflect the change from Phase I Service to Phase II Service effective on February 21, 2006;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF CLAY COUNTY, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES** that the 2003 year Resolution be amended and that the wireless enhanced 9-1-1 charge imposed upon each wireless telecommunications connection subscribed to by subscribers whose billing address is within the jurisdiction of Clay County, Georgia be increased to \$1.50 per month per wireless connection provided to each telephone subscriber.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that said wireless charge shall be imposed beginning March 1, 2006.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to each wireless service supplier providing services in Clay County, Georgia.
