Regular Meeting

7:00 p.m.

- 1) **Call to Order and Opening Prayer**
Chairman David Shivers called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with a prayer. In attendance were Chairman David Shivers, Vice Chairman Barry Waters, and Commissioners James Davenport, Walt Killingsworth, and Radar Fair, Sr. as well as County Administrator Spencer Mueller, County Attorney Bill Mills, Accounts Payable Clerk Lori McMullen, and County Clerk Adria Williams.
- 2) **Agenda Approval**
One item was added to the agenda:
4b. Samuel Davis- Discuss Mobile Home Application

Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to approve the agenda with the addendum. Motion seconded by Commissioner Fair. All in favor; motion carried.
- 3) **Annual Appointments - None**
- 4) **Presentations before the Board**
 - a. David Baldwin, Chief Ranger, GA Forestry Commission- Clay County Annual Report
Chief Ranger Baldwin presented the Board with Clay County's Annual Report. He thanked them for signing the Forestry Commission Agreement and reported that Clay County had only one fire for the year. The Commission issued 365 burn permits and Chief Ranger Baldwin encouraged the Board to tell citizens to get burn permits before burning. Constituents can do so by either calling the local office or the automated system and by accessing the Commission online. He made mention to the Board to address their concerns, if any, to Rick Hatten, Director of Field Operations.
 - b. Sammie Davis- Mobile Home
Mr. Davis asked the Board's permission to temporarily store a mobile home on his lot while he goes through the zoning process. The Board briefly discussed the time to be allotted to Mr. Davis. Motion made by Commissioner Fair to grant Mr. Davis permission for 90 days temporary storage of the mobile home while he goes through the zoning process. Motion seconded by Vice Chairman Waters. All in favor; motion carried.
- 5) **Minutes**
 - a. August 17, 2010 Regular Meeting
Chairman Shivers noted that the following sentences needed to be added to line item 7b between the third and fourth sentences of the minutes:
"Chairman Shivers stated that they didn't drop the fees. They offered not to provide the service of coming to the Commission Board meetings."
Motion made by Commissioner Fair to approve the August 17, 2010 Regular Meeting minutes with changes. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried.
- 6) **Correspondence Requiring Action**
- 7) **Unfinished Business**
 - a. Discussion and Decision on Liberty National Life Insurance Company
The Board needs clarification on *under the influence of alcohol and drugs* from item five of the policy, Exclude from Coverage.
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to postpone this issue until returned from insurance agent. Motion seconded by Commissioner Fair. All in favor; motion carried.
 - b. RVRC FY11 Planning and Zoning Technical Assistance Fees
The proposal from RVRC is not complete but once it is, it will be submitted to the Board.
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to postpone the issue until the next meeting. Motion died from lack of a second. There was a brief discussion on how long this issue is dragging on. Motion made by Commissioner Fair to approve the \$3500 contract offer from RVRC. Motion died from lack of a second.



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Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to remove from the agenda until we hear from RVRC. Motion seconded by Commissioner Fair. All in favor; motion carried. Vice Chairman Waters specified that the motion was not a refusal to the proposal; the item is being removed from the agenda until the proposal is ready.

- c. **Bank Charges- Bank Proposals with Interest Rates on Checking Accounts**
The Administrator reviewed the updates on the interest rates and security pledges on the certificate of deposits. Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to postpone until the County Administrator can return to the Board written proposals from all the financial institutions so they can make an informed decision. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. Commissioner Killingsworth, Commissioner Fair, and Chairman Shivers voted nay. Two for, three against; the motion failed. Motion made by Commissioner Fair to proceed with the Bank of Early. Motion seconded by Chairman Shivers. Chairman Shivers asked Commissioner Fair if he would accept amending his motion to include, "When the County Administrator gets what he told us in writing then the transfer will be made." Commissioner Fair accepted. Commissioner Fair, Chairman Shivers, and Commissioner Killingsworth voted yea. Vice Chairman Waters and Commissioner Davenport were no votes. Majority rule, motion carried.
- d. **Discussion on Regulations for Pre-Owned Manufactured Homes**
Motion made by Commissioner Davenport to postpone until the Planning Commission has a chance to review and then the Board can schedule a workshop afterwards. Motion seconded by Commissioner Fair. All in favor; motion carried. Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to have the workshop and discussion with the zoning board after their meeting on the 15th. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried.
- e. **Water Contract Discussion- follow up from 07/20/10 Regular Meeting**
Motion made by Commissioner Davenport to have a workshop to discuss water. Motion seconded by Vice Chairman Waters. All in favor; motion carried. Motion made by Commissioner Davenport to schedule the workshop for September 23rd at 5:30 p.m. Motion seconded by Vice Chairman Waters. All in favor; motion carried.
- f. **Follow-up on Grass-cutting State Roads in Clay County**
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to approve the purchase of at least one mower if not two to enable Clay County's Road Department Public Works to maintain the public safety and welfare and cut the grass. Motion died from lack of a second. Motion made by Vice Chairman to postpone until next year and revisit the issue at that time. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried.
- g. **Discussion on County Clerk Evaluation**
There was a brief discussion on the County Clerks evaluation process. The Board will complete the evaluations provided to them and give to the County Clerk once completed for her comments.
- h. **Approval of Resolution 10-064 Amend FY10 Water Fund**
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to approve Resolution 10-064. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried.
- i. **Approval of Resolution 10-065 Amend FY10 Gen Fund Water Loan**
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to approve Resolution 10-065. Motion seconded by Commissioner Fair. All in favor; motion carried.
- j. **Approval of Resolution 10-070 Conditional Funding of County Agencies**
Motion made by Commissioner Fair to approve Resolution 10-070. Motion seconded by Vice Chairman Waters. All in favor; motion carried.
- k. **Office Copier Contract Proposal (from 8/17/10 meeting)**
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to postpone to get additional information, bids, and options before the Board. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport.
Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to postpone until next year. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried.

The Commissioners agreed that they will participate in the Christmas Parade but will not make a donation.



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- b. Discussion on EMS billing issue
The Board discussed excusing the balance of a Clay County EMS transport customer. Motion made by Vice Chairman to excuse the remainder of the bill. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to withdraw his motion. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to suspend billing until its determined if there are any other recoveries from the accident available. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried. The County Clerk is to verify with Blue Cross Blue Shield if Clay County EMS is listed with them as a Patient Preferred Organization Group.
 - c. ACCG 2010 Legislative Leadership Conference Voting Delegate
Vice Chairman Waters volunteered to represent Clay County as the voting delegate at the conference. Motion made by Commissioner Fair to nominate Vice Chairman Waters to represent our county in voting in Atlanta. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All in favor; motion carried.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, it shall be the policy of the Board of Commissioners to implement amending the budget for its offending agency, board, commission, or authority upon its determining that the said entity has expended budgeted county funds that are not the best use of the public funds; and.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the policy of the Board of Commissioners is to amend the offending entity's budget in an amount to be determined by the Board of Commissioners.





