MINUTES

**Special Called Meeting
 October 14, 2010**

- 1) **Call to Order**
 Chairman Shivers called the special called meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Chairman David Shivers, Vice Chairman Barry Waters, and Commissioners Walt Killingsworth, James Davenport, and Radar Fair, Sr. were all in attendance as well as County Administrator Spencer Mueller, and County Clerk Adria Williams.

- 2) **Agenda Approval**
 Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to approve the agenda. Motion seconded by Commissioner Fair. All in favor; motion carried.

- 3) **New Business**
 - a. **Review of Accounts Payable Invoices**
 The Commission reviewed the accounts payable invoices for approval. Vice Chairman Waters commented on the \$16,000 inmate expense invoice. Commissioner Fair stated that he saw it the day before. Chairman Shivers stated that he registered for the Georgia Association of Regional Commissions conference scheduled for November 3 – 5, 2010. Chairman Shivers asked how much was budgeted for Commissioner's Travel. The County Clerk provided him with a printout of the amounts budgeted for Commissioners Travel and Commissioner Education and Travel budget accounts. There was a question on expense checks for Commissioner Waters; Commissioner Fair asked if it was for two people due to the reimbursement being for \$51.85. Vice Chairman stated it was for the cost of his food only from the Atlanta Marriott; if they wanted, he had the receipts at home. There was a question with the Public Defender's invoice. Commissioner Killingsworth thought that they needed to speak with the judge again. He asked where his office was. The Administrator stated he would have to check on it. Commissioner Killingsworth didn't think it should be paid; there was an electric bill for around \$400. The vendor address is 181 North Cuthbert Street, Colquitt, GA. Administrator Mueller stated that he's with Pataula Circuit. The amount is our prorated share of a \$6030 bill; Robert M. Thomas is the attorney. The Commission went through the charges on the invoice and discussed not being able to justify whether the expenses incurred were for public defense versus private. Motion made by Vice Chairman Waters to pay the bills with the exclusion of the Public Defender's which needs verification. Motion seconded by Commissioner Davenport. All votes in favor; motion carried.

 There being no further business the special called meeting adjourned at 5:25 p.m.


